

# PRIMARY TIMETABLE



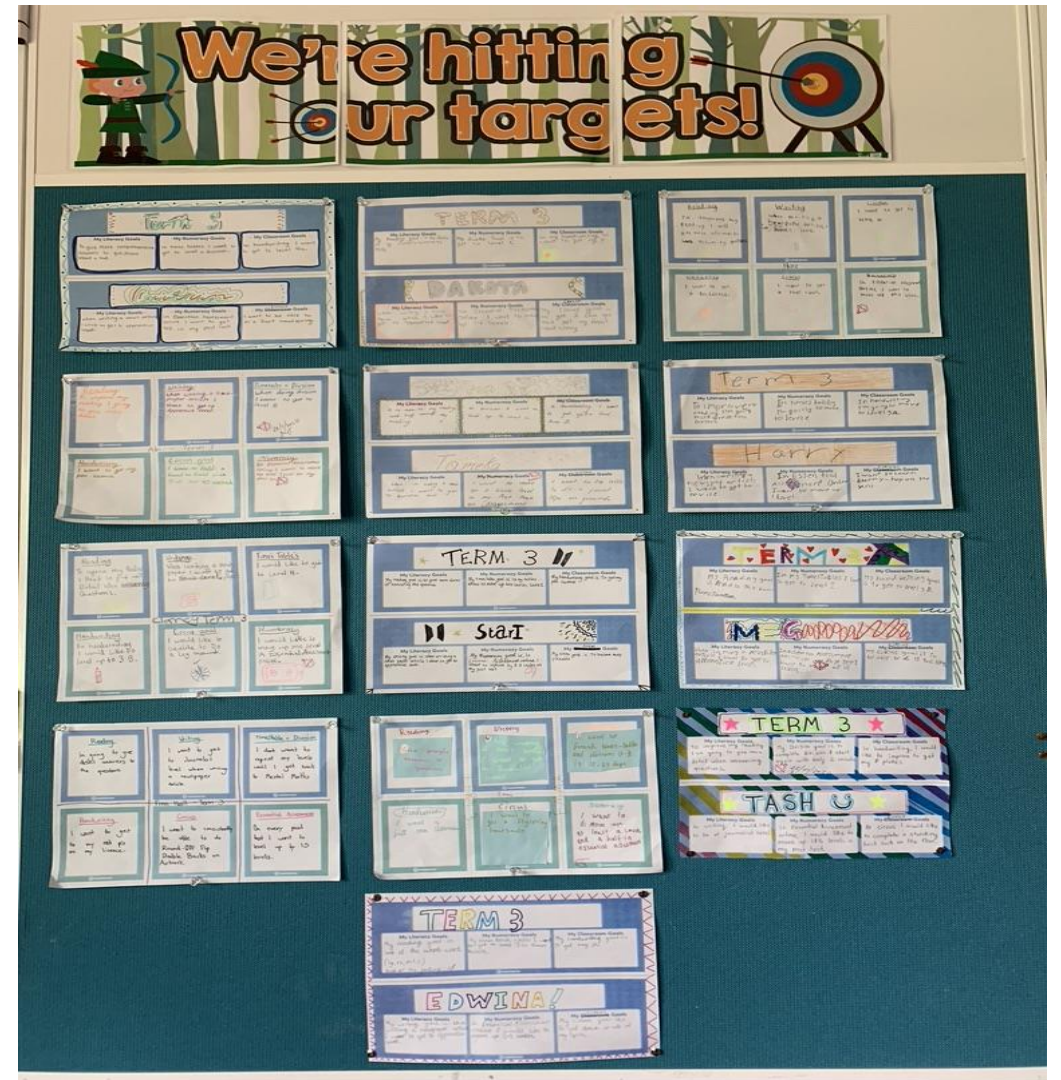

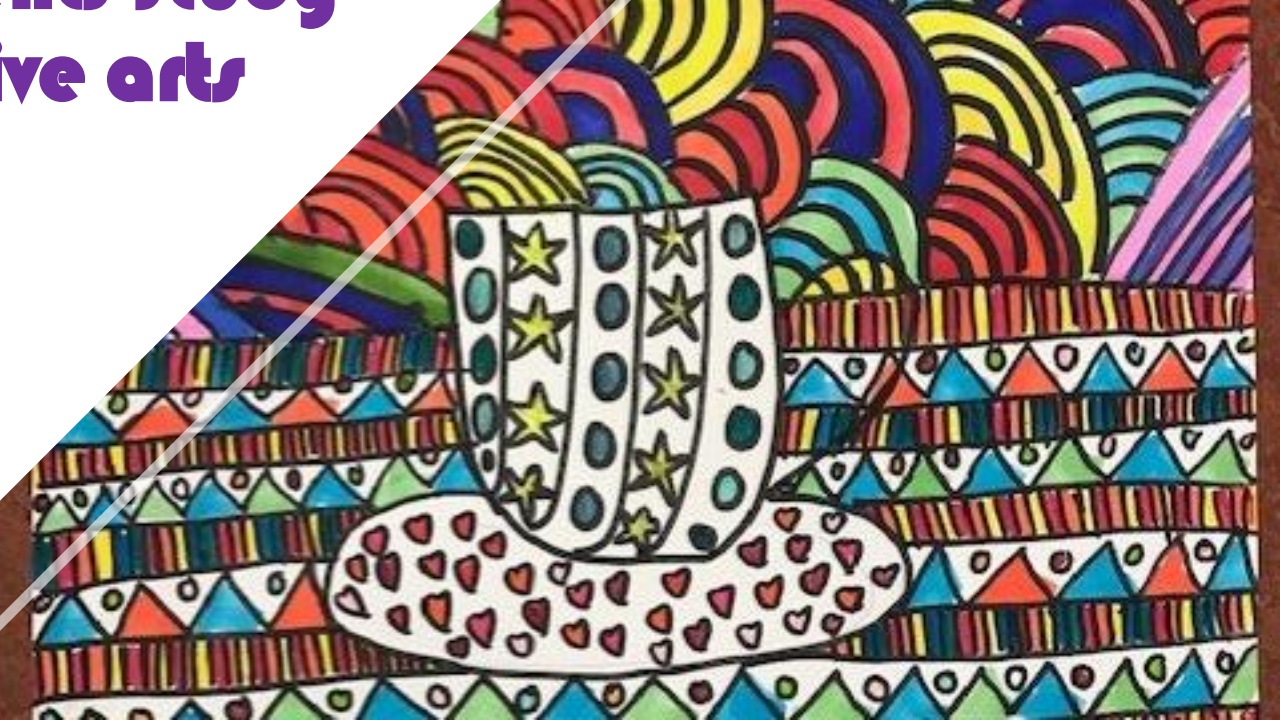
