This week in science the year 8/9 class extracted DNA from strawberries. All living things have DNA. It can be seen easily with the naked eye when collected from thousands of cells. We welcomed our visitors from Vietnam on Tuesday. Their presence brings new perspectives and strengthens our global connections. Our students are making them feel very welcome.


### 'Spherical'
