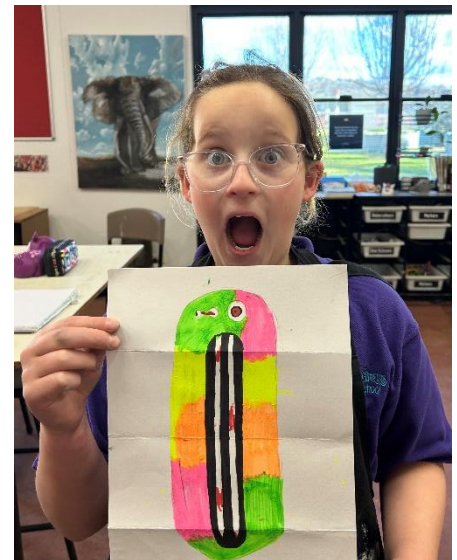
Primary Class Art

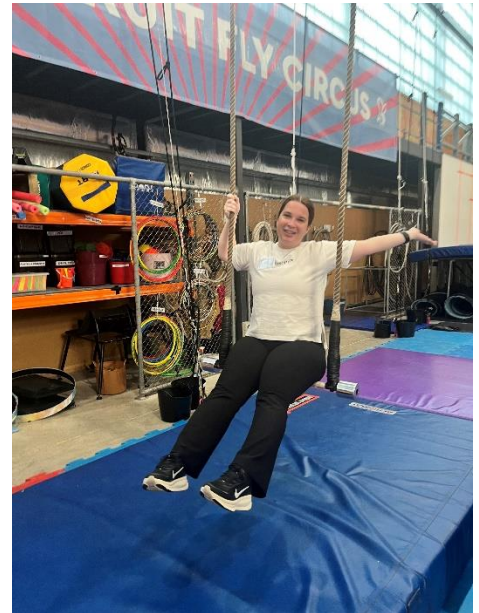
