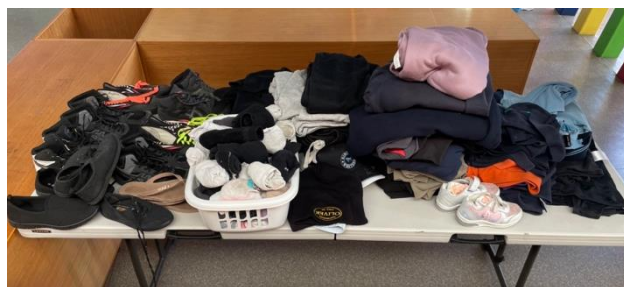
Preparation group will train in-school 12 - 2:45pm; students can be picked up from Circus at 2:45pm. Foundation group B will train after-school 3 - 6pm.
